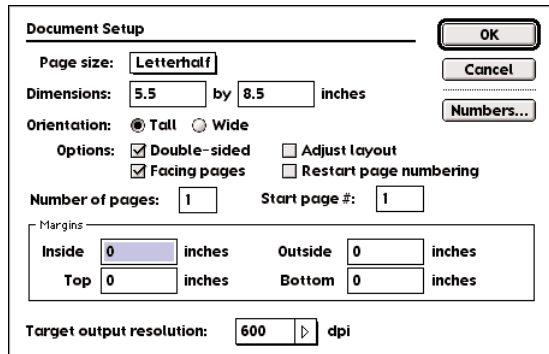
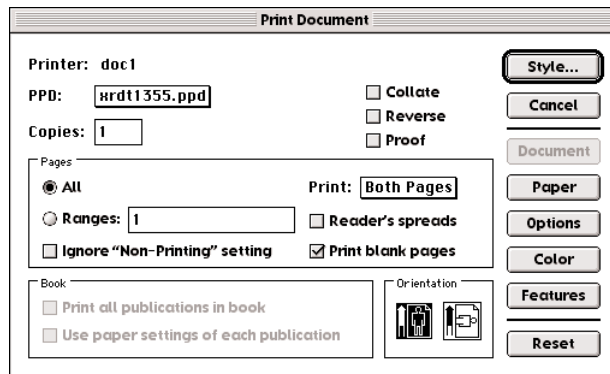


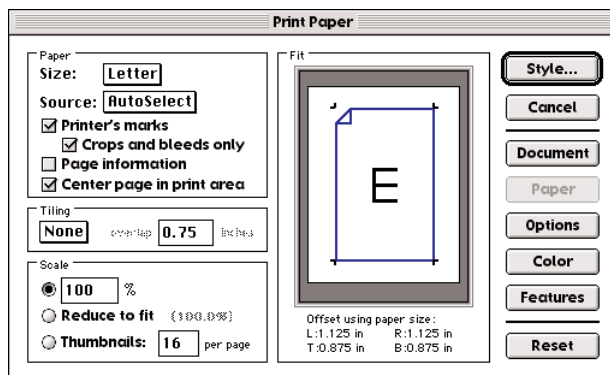
## Creating a Postscript file (.ps) using the Adobe Postscript Driver in Pagemaker.



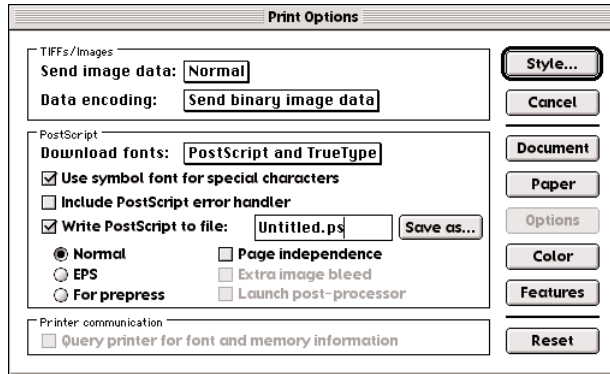
In Document Setup, set up your page sizes, and set the Output Resolution to 600 dpi.



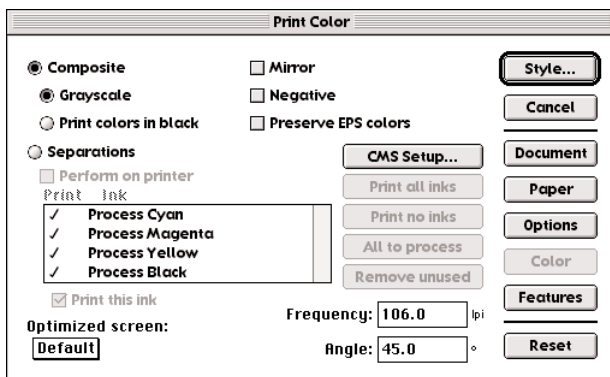
With your printer already selected through the Chooser, select the Xerox Docutech PPD. Also, be sure to turn on "Print Blank Pages".



Set the paper size to "Letter", with Printer's Marks set to "Crops and Bleeds Only". Please also "Center page in print area", with no scaling (100%)



Change the Image data from “Optimized” to “Normal”, and choose a name for your postscript file (.ps)



Set color to “Composite and Grayscale”, and change the Frequency to “106 lpi”, and the Angle to “45.0” degrees.

Then go ahead and click “Print”
